PRESENTATION:

The School of Higher Studies - Global Inequalities and Social Justice: South North Dialogues, promoted by the Postgraduate Program in Law of the University of Brasilia (PPGD/UnB) and the Latin American College of Global Studies (FLACSO/Brazil), developed extension, graduate and postdoctoral activities. The objective was to provide a reflection on global inequalities and social justice, a broad and complex issue to which several theoretical-methodological perspectives converge from different disciplinary fields. The program was attended by several professors from recognized institutions in Latin America, Europe, and North America, invited to discuss their local realities according to a perspective of internationalization that seeks to promote more horizontal and pluralistic international academic dialogues. The School began its activities in the second semester of 2019. In 2020, given the context of the pandemic, we have reduced its activities, interrupting the arrival of foreign professors.

Objective:

This seminar aims to bring prestigious colleagues around the topic celebrated by our School of Higher Studies. In addition, we opened the space for the presentation of research developed by the post-doctors who participated in the School and for the launch of the collection with their articles. Sessions will be divided into debates with external guests and discussion tables with the School's participants.
